- (a) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to several newspapers reports and particularly by correspondent M V Kamath of Wa-hington dated August 23 1977 to the effect that 15 foreign students including Indians who had got jobs in the World Bank as trainees have now been served with deportation orders by the Government of USA even through they are midway in their studies and
- (b) it so the facts thereof and the action taken thereon?

(b) According to ou information 15 foreign students including some Indians had taken summer jobs with the World Bank as trainees It turned out that this was in contravention of the student visa conditions of USA which provide that a student cannot accept a job off-campus without the permission of US Immigration authorities The students were served no tices of illegal work and asked leave the United States Eventually the US authorities relented in the matter and none of the students were actually deported They were warned to observe all the conditions of visas granted to them
