

### Literacy Centres in Delhi and States

5317. SHRI PIUS TIRKEY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are opening 1000 literacy Centres in Delhi according to the news item appearing in the Indian Express dated 27th February, 1978;

(b) whether Government plan to open such centres in States also, where education is very much needed; and

(c) if so, the time by which these centres will be opened in the States and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (DR. PRATAP CHANDRA CHUNDER): (a) According to the information furnished by Delhi Administration there is a plan to open 1000 adult literacy centres during 1978-79 in the Union Territory.

(b) and (c) Under the National Adult Education Programme a number of adult literacy centres are proposed to be established by all State Governments and other Union Territories.

(a) state the numbers of Type I, II, III and IV quarters constructed by the C.P.W.D. and handed over to the Estate office and different pools during 1977 in Delhi;

(b) the number of the quarters category-wise allotted by the Estate Office and each pool till March, 1978;

(c) percentage of category-wise demand met of the Estate Office/each pool till now; and

(d) the time by which remaining non-allottees will be allotted accommodation?

(b) and (c): Total number of general pool quarters allotted till March, 1978 including the quarters mentioned above is 41,620. Category-wise break-up and percentage of satisfaction is as follows:—

(c) if so, the number thereof?
