Delbi Centres in Literacy and States

5317. SHRI PIUS TIRKEY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are opening 1000 literacy Centres in Delhi according to the news item appearing in the Indian Express dated 2rth February, 1978;
- (b) whether Government plan to open such centres in States also, where education is very much needed; and
- (c) if so, the time by which these centres will be opened in the States and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (DR. PRATAP CHANDRA CHUN-DER): (a) According to the information furnished by Delhi Administration there is a plan to open 1000 adult literacy centres during 1978-79 in the Union Territory.

(b) and (c) Under the National Adult Education Programme a number of adult literacy centres are proposed to be established by all State Governments and other Union Territories.
