Detection of Cancer Cases

547. SHRI K. RAMAMURTHY: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the steps taken or proposed to be taken for a country-wide network of cancer detection cases by using the "Pap Test"; and

(b) if not, the reasons for the delay in initiating these steps?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) The "PAP Smear Test" facilities are being introduced in five institutions having Post Partum Units during the current financial year on a pilot basis. Extension of facilities in other institutions will be considered on the basis of the results obtained in these institutions.
