Basic Facilities at Guna Station

966. SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state: २११६

(a) whether it is a fact that in the absence of adequate basic facilities (i.e. seating arrangement for passengers at the platform, sufficient number of Coolies, proper arrangement for purchase of tickets etc.) people are facing difficulties at Guna station of Kota-Bina section of Western Railway; and

(b) if so, what steps are being taken to mitigate people's difficulties?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHEO NARAIN): (a) and (b). Guna Station is provided with the basic amenities. Augmentation of these amenities is a continuous process and is done in consultation with the Railway Users' Amenities Committee and in accordance with the availability of funds. The station is provided with 10 benches and 10 additional benches are proposed to be provided on the island platform which is under construction. Three licensed porters and one booking window is provided which is considered adequate for the present level of traffic.

Assistance to Vietnam in Rail Transport Development

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHEO NARAIN): (a) and (b). A three-member Technical Delegation from the Indian Railways visited Vietnam in January, 1978 to study the developmental needs of some sectors of Vietnam's Railways.
