(a) has Government's attentions been drawn to the news item appeared in the 'Financial Express' dated 8-6-78 under the heading "Single price for pig iron, SAIL Units Flout JPC directives"; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI KARIA MUNDA): (a) Yes. Sir.

(b) The decision to keep the margin between J.P.C. price and Stockyard price at Rs. 35/. was applicable to different categories of steel only and not pig iron. There was, therefore, no flouting of J.P.C. directive as reported.

Pending Passport Applications

603. SHRI AHMED M. PATEL: SHRI AMAR SINH V. RATHAWA

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state: (a) the number of pending passport applications as on 31st March, 1978 with regional passport office-wise; and

(b) the steps taken by Government to clear the arrears?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SAMARENDRA KUNDU): (a) A statement showing the number of passport applications pending as on 31st March, 1978, Regional Passport Office-wise, is laid on the table of the House.

(b) Government have sanctioned a total of 375 additional posts of clerks for the Regional Passport Offices with effect from February, 1978 for clearing the arrears. In addition, 23 posts of Passport Officers (Assistant Passport Officers, Public Relations Officers and Superintendents) have been created during the period May 1977 to April, 1978 to cope with the arrears as well as the increasing work load of the Regional Passport Offices.

Passports in respect of a large number of these pending applications could not be issued because the applications were not complete and information or documents or photographs were lacking. The Regional Passport Offices have whitten to the Applicants again asking them to supply the requisite documents/information for want of which the applicants are pending; the applicants have been informed that they should supply the documents within three weeks.

As a result of these measures, the effective arrears in the Regional Passport Offices have been progressively reduced and brought down. to 1.75.892 as on June 30, 1978.
