Naval Academy

163. SHRI O. V. ALEGESAN: Will the DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) is there any proposal to establish a Naval Academy;

(b) what are the States that have suggested suitable sites for the purpose; and

(c) what are the site/sites recommended by the teams of Experts which inspected the various sites suggested?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) There is already a Naval Academy which is housed, on a temporary basis, in some old barracks/hutments in Cochin. A proposal to establish the Academy on a permanent basis at a suitable site with expanded training capacity is under consideration.

(b) Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Goa.

(c) The team of Experts have recommended Madras and Porbander in order of preference as the suitable sites for the new Naval Academy. The recommendations are under consideration.

Search for Oil in Kerala

164. SHRI C. K. CHANDRAPPAN: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have decided to search for oil this time at the north of Calicut in Kerala;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) how much crude Government are going to import this year; and

(d) how much crude Government expect to produce this year and details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA): (a) No work for oil exploration in the onshore area of Calicut is currently in progress, nor is there any plan at present for such work in the near future. However, in the offshore, Geophysical survey in the shelf area between Calicut and Mangalore is planned to be conducted during the period February-May, 1979.

(b) As at (a) above.

(c) Crude oil imports during 1978-79 are expected to be approximately 15 million tonnes.

(d) About 11.76 million tonnes of crude oil is likely to be produced in the country during 1978-79 as per details given below:—
