Mehta Committee set up by the Munistry of shipping and Transport had made certain recommendations for import of eduble oil cargo through various ports in India including Bombay. The recommendations have been accepted by Government, and the State Trading Corporation, who are the canalising agency for importing eduble oil are already handling imported eduble oil cargo at Kandla, Madras, Vishakapatnam and Calcuta in addition to Bombay. They are also propring to provide storage tanks connected with pipelines for direct ducharge from ships at New Kandla Port and also requisite storage tanks and railway using facilities both at Haldia and Budge-Budge.

In view of this, it was decided that future detention orders in respect of persons within there States would be issued by the Central Gevennment or its specially empowered effect. These detention orders are, hewever, being duly executed by the concerned State Governments.
