

## WOMEN EMPLOYEES

602. Prof. D. C. Sharma: (a) Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state the number of women at present employed in the various grades of service in the A.I.R., Delhi and the Press Information Bureau, Delhi?

(b) How many of them are permanent and how many of them are on a contract basis?

## EMPLOYMENT DUE TO DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

603. Shri Dabhi: Will the Minister of Planning be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that according to the Planning Commission's calculations, as embodied in the Five Year Plan, the total approximate number of persons, who would get employment during the Plan period, as a result of the various programmes mentioned in the Five Year Plan, will be about 57½ lakhs annually; and

(b) if so how many persons have, up to this time, got employment in various works, projects and industries in each State?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): (a) Employment of different kinds in consequence of development schemes in the Five Year Plan was estimated at 52½ lakhs.

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC SURVEY OF DISPLACED PERSONS

Shri Gidwani: (a) Will the Minister of Rehabilitation be pleased to state whether Government have received the report of the socio-economic survey of the displaced persons living in (i) the tenements constructed by Government in the city of Delhi and (ii) the newly developed colonies of displaced persons in Delhi State?

(b) If so, what is the average yearly income of a family consisting of five members living in (i) those tenements and (ii) the newly developed colonies?

(c) What is the amount of yearly expenditure incurred by each such family on rent, transport and education of their children?

The Deputy Minister of Rehabilitation (Shri J. K. Bhowale): (a) to (c). A socio-economic survey of the rehabilitation colonies in and around Delhi has been carried out at the request of the Government of India by Dr. V. K. R. V. Rao, Director, Delhi School of Economics, Delhi University, Delhi. His report is awaited.
