the objectives intended to achieve better.

- (e) A copy of the agreement executed between Government and the Union was laid on the Table of the House in reply to the starred question No. 1425 by Shri M. L. Agrawal on the 18th April, 1953.
- (f) The Agreement is for the threeyear period 1st November, 1952, to 31st October, 1955. The agreement does not stipulate that the profits will be made over to Government.
