The Minister of Health (Rajkumari Amrit Kaur): (a) The sanitary arrangements are not entirely satisfactory.

(b) The Delhi State Government are taking necessary steps in consultation with the Delhi Municipal Committee to bring about the desired improvements.

ROAD TRANSPORT

607. Sardar Hukam Singh: Will the Minister of Transport be pleased to state the policy of the Government of India towards the future expansion of road transport (motor) service in the country?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): Under the Constitution, the subject of road transport services falls within the executive jurisdiction of the State Governments, who are primarily responsible for policy decisions on the subject. The Government of India are, however, interested in the coordinated development of road and rail transport and their views on the manner in which this coordination should be effected are embodied in the Road Transport Corporations Act of 1950.

DELIVERY OF RAILWAY PARCELS
