the cattle to the same extent as berseem. It can grow without irrigation, which is its speciality. It is, therefore, most suitable for being grown during the months of November to April after late paddy has been harvested where berseem would not grow under unirrigated conditions. This is a fertilising clover crop like berseem but unlike berseem it does not require irrigation.

WATER-LOGGED AREAS NEAR HOWRAH RAILWAY STATION
