- **657.** Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:
- (a) the number and locations of camps set up so far during the year 1954-55 under the new scheme of the Auxiliary Territorial Force;
- (b) the number of persons trained in each of them; and
- (c) at what other places such camps are proposed to be organised during the remaining part of the year?

The Deputy Minister of Defence Sardar Majithia): (a) Three camps have so far been held, one each at Simla, Patiala and Bageshwar.

- (b) 424 at Simla, 428 at Patiala and 479 at Bageshwar (in District Almora).
- (c) The programme of the Auxiliary Territorial Force camps to be held in the ensuing winter has not yet been finalised.

## INDUSTRIAL FINANCE CORPORATION

- 658. Shri Gadilingana Gowd: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to refer to the reply of starred question No. 727 asked on the 6th March, 1954 and state:
- (a) the number of applications further received since that date by the Industrial Finance Corporation from the industrial concerns of the Andhra State for financial aid:
- (b) the amount sanctioned in each case; and
- (c) the names of the industrial concerns which have drawn the sanctioned loans?

The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shri A. C. Guha): (a) No regular

application has been received by the Corporation since then. One industrial concern however wrote for a loan of Rs. 20 Lakhs and it has been asked by the Corporation to put in a regular application which has not yet been received.

## SMUGGLING

- 660. Shri Rishang Kelshing: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that a large quantity of goods is being smuggled into India through Moreh, outposts in Manipur;
- (b) if so, the number of smuggling cases so far detected by the Customs Department at Moreh, Palel and Imphal during 1953-54 and 1954-55; and
- (c) the amount realised as fines from the smuggling of goods detected during the years mentioned above?

The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shri A. C. Guha): (a) and (b). There is no reason to believe that a large quantity of goods is being smuggled into India through Moreh outpost in Manipur. The number of cases of
