PARTIAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME

*250. **Shri Bahadur Singh:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the number of students who have been given loans for passage only under the Partial Financial Assistance Scheme since the 1st January, 1954;

(b) the total amount of loan advanced under this scheme during this period; and

(c) whether any recoveries of the principal and the interest on the loan advanced in previous years have been effected?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das):

(a) 10 (Ten).

(b) Rs. 18,260/- (Rupees eighteen thousand, two hundred and sixty only).

(c) Yes.

Shri Bahadur Singh: May I know what was the total number of applicants? Were there any cases in which assistance could not be afforded under the scheme on account of paucity of funds, though they deserved such assistance?

Dr. M. M. Das: The total number of scholars who have been given this loan is, as I have said, ten. In addition, loans to twelve students amounting approximately to Rs. 23,166 have been approved subject to a report from the State Governments, about the financial condition of the guardians as required in the rules.
