FERTILIZERS

148. Shri Gadilingana Gowd: Will the Minister of Production be pleased to state the quantity of fertilizer allotted to the Andhra State for the year 1954-55?

The Minister of Production (Shri K. C. Reddy): Allotments of fertilizer are made on the basis of the calendar year. 65,000 tons have been allotted to the Andhra State for 1954.

INSULATOR FACTORY

149. Dr. Ram Subhag Singh: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) whether any insulator Factory exists in India;

(b) if so, the name of the place where that factory is located; and

(c) the annual production of that factory?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari):

(a) and (b). Yes, Sir. There are seven factories manufacturing Electrical Porcelain Insulators. Five units are located at Calcutta, one at Bangalore and another at Bombay.

(c) Total production during 1953 at these factories has been of the order of 30 lakh pieces.
