

## TRADE DELEGATIONS

456. **Sardar Iqbal Singh:** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the number of trade delegations sent abroad during the years 1953 and 1954 upto the end of September, 1954;

(b) the personnel of the delegations and the purpose in each case; and

(c) the names of the countries which they visited and how long they stayed there?

**The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari):**

## TENTS

457. **Shri N. B. Chowdhury:** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the quantity and value of tents exported from India during the years 1952-53, 1953-54 and upto the 30th September, 1954 in 1954-55; and

(b) the names of the countries to which these have been exported?

**The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari):**

(a) and (b). A statement showing the quantities of tents licensed for export from November, 1952 to September, 1954 and the major destinations to which they were shipped is attached. [See Appendix III, annexure No. 29.] The figures prior to November, 1952 are not available. The value of the tents and the quantity actually exported are not known.

(c) the percentage of the displaced persons who are cultivators and have been allotted lands for cultivation and tenure of such lands; and

(d) what is the position of security of tenure of the displaced persons in their tenancy?
