ACCOMMODATION FOR AMBASSADORS AEROAD

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Defence (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) No. scales of accommodation in foreign countries are not equated to the scales of accommodation in India. The accommodation is provided after taking into account various factors such as the importance of the Mission, the grade and status of the Ambassador, Envoy etc. and the representational duties required to be performed etc.

(b) and (c). Where accommodation is available our Ambassadors and Envoys etc. are required to occupy it straightaway unless there are special reasons such as the accommodation not being in a fit condition for immediate occupation. Where accommodation is not available, the Ambassadors and Envoys etc. are temporarily put

up in hotels and are required to move into accommodation as soon as it can be found.
