(iii) arrangements were made to divert traffic by alternative routes, including rail-cumriver and rail-cum-road routes.

DAMAGE TO CROPS

- 36. Shri Anirudha Sinha: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:
- (a) the extent of damage to the standing sugarcane crop in North Bihar due to the recent floods; and
- (b) how it has affected the production of sugar in the coming season?

The Minister of Agriculture (Dr. P. S. Deshmukh): (a) About 50,000 acres of sugarcane crop has been affected by floods in Bihar causing a loss of about 1.8 lakh tons of sugarcane.

(b) Inspite of damage to cane crop by floods, the production of sugar in Bihar during the current season is expected to be slightly more than that in 1953-54. The area under sugarcane in Bihar in 1954-55, according to the first forecast, is about 2 per cent. more than that in 1953-54 season and the yield per acre is also expected to be a little higher than in the last season.

DINING CARS

37. Shri Anirudha Sinha: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state the trains in the different Railway Zones in which dining cars have been thrown open to all classes of passengers?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): All trains on which dining cars are provided.
