SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY

- *104, Dr. Rama Rao: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have requested the All India Sanskrit Sammelan to submit a scheme to start a Sanskrit University;
- (b) if so, whether the Sammelan has submitted such a scheme to Government; and
- (c) if the reply to part (b) above be in the affirmative, the details of the scheme?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c). Do not arise.

Dr. Rama Rao: May I know if the Government has any scheme to increase the number of Chairs for Sanskrit or strengthen them in the universities?

Dr. M. M. Das: We have already added one seat of Sanskrit in some university, most probably Andhra—I do not remember exactly. Moveover, Government is giving grants to a large

number of institutions who are carrying on research work in Sanskrit.

Shri K. K. Basu: May I know whether there is any proposal to establish a Sanskrit University in West Bengal?

Dr. M. M. Das: So far as the Central Government is concerned, we have received no such proposal.

- (c) whether it is a fact that blood test of Onges was made;
- (d) if so, whether any racial connection with any other people living in any part of the world have been traced; and
- (e) what has been the fate of the 'friendly tribes' of the islands who once numbered several thousands?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das): (a) Yes.

(b) Friendly relations have been established with the Onges not only on the coastal belt but also in the interior of Little Andaman Island. The Little Andaman was crossed for the first time from East to West. Infor-
