(b) No amount has so far been sanctioned or utilised. The proposals of the Andhra Government are under examination at present.

PISCICULTURE

- 197. Shri S. C. Samanta: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:
- (a) the amount spent by the Central Government to encourage pisciculture in India during the last five years;
- (b) the names of the States that have started pisciculture;
- (c) the nature of assistance they are receiving from the Central Government;
- (d) the arrangements made to collect good fry of different kinds of fish; and
- (e) whether it is a fact that the price of fish has come down recently?

The Minister of Agriculture (Dr. P. S. Deshmukh): (a) and (b). A statement showing the assistance given to State Governments by the Central Government under its Grow More Food (Fisheries) Schemes is laid on the Table of the House. [See Appendix 1, annexure No. 63.]

- (c) Apart from financial assistance help is given by way of technical advice, supply of fish seed providing road transport facilities etc.
- (d) Technical advice and help is given to State Governments whenever required, in surveying their resources of fish fry.

In the meantime, the Central Island Fisheries Research Station arranges to supply fry of selected species of carps to State Governments.

(e) Yes, to some extent.
