KUHI RAILWAY STATION

- 417. Shri N. A. Borkar: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the people of Kuhi area, District Nagpur, made a representation to Government for construction of a Waiting Hall at Kuhi station; and
- (b) if so, the decision taken thereon?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

RAILWAY STAFF QUARTERS

- 418. Shri A. K. Gopalan: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:
- (a) whether residential quarters for the Railway Auditor was built at a cost of Rs. 40,000 in West Hill in Kozhikode;
- (b) if so, when the construction was completed and how long it has been lying vacant; and
