(a) whether the expert Enquiry Committee on Coke-Oven Projects appointed by the Planning Commission has finished its work and submitted its report; and (b) if so, whether the report has been considered and decision taken with regard to the establishment of Coke-Oven and by-product plants by the West Bengal Government?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): (a) An interim report dealing with the Cokeoven plant and allied schemes, envisaging the recovery of by-products from coke-oven gas and products from the distillation of coal-tar, was submitted to the Planning Commission by the Coke-oven Projects Enquiry Committee on 31st March, 1955.

(b) The interim report is expected to be considered by the Planning Commission in consultation with the Central Ministries at an early date.
