SUGAR PRODUCTION

727. Shri D. C. Sharma: Dr. J. N. Parekh;

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

- (a) the total production of sugar during the year 1954; and
- (b) how far this production fell short of the requirements of the country?

The Deputy Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri M. V. Krishnappa):
(a) 10.01 lakh tons during 1953-54 season (from 1st November, 1953 to 31st October, 1954).

(b) By about eight lakh tons.

- (b) The total amount sanctioned by the Government of India as loan to the State Government for the purpose was Rs. 120·18 lakhs (Rs. 82·68 lakhs for T.C.M. Programmes and Rs. 37·5 lakhs for G.M.F. Programme).
- (c) The information regarding the amount actually spent is not available.
