(b) whether Government propose to take steps for keeping time-table charts at every stop?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) The Delhi Road Transport Authority have put up 64 frequency boards at important stops.

(b) They do not propose to put up such boards at every stop.

EGYPTIAN RICE AND MAIZE

- 1001. Shri S. C. Samanta: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that some varieties of Egyptian rice and maize are being tried at the Himayatsagar Agricultural Farm in Hyderabad;
- (b) if so, how many varieties of each;
- (c) whether any hybrid variety is also being experimented on; and
- (d) if so, the results of the experiments?

The Minister of Agriculture (Dr. P. S. Deshmukh): (a) Yes.

- (b) Ten improved varieties of Egyptain Rice and one variety of malze are being tried.
- (c) Yes, the imported maize variety under trial is a hybrid variety.
- (d) The results of the experiments with the rice varieties show that none of these Egyptian varieties can be used as straight introductions in Hyderabad. Experiments on maize are still in progress.
