#### SCHOLARBHIES

- (a) whether Government are aware that students from the Orissa State studying at present in the Veterinary College of the Punjab State are put to hardship due to irregular payment of Scholarships awarded to them by the Government of India: and
- (b) if so, the steps that are being taken in the matter?

The Minister of Education and Natural Resources and Scientific Research (Maulana Azad); (a) and (b). Only one student from the Orissa State is studying at present in a Veterinary College of the Punjab State who is in receipt of the Government of India scholarship under the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes Scholarships Scheme. His completed application for the scholarship for 1954-55 was received in the Ministry of Education on the 25th November, 1954. The amount of both the instalments of his scholarship was sent to the Principal of his College for disbursement to him in January 1955. There has thus been no delay in making the payment.
