(b) the quantities of the different volatile oils produced in India in 1954 as against 1950?

The Minister of Production (Shri K. C. Reddy): (a) If by volatile oils the hon. Member means mineral oils which vaporise, the volatile oils produced in India are motor spirit, kerosene and vaporising oil and the answer so far as these are concerned is in the affirmative.

(b) The increase in motor spirit production was about three-fold, in vaporising oil about twice, and in kerosene about 66 per cent.
