निर्माण, आवास और संभरण मंत्री (सरदार स्वर्ण सिंह) : देश से बाहर माल खरीदने वाले दो कार्यालय यानी आई० एस० डी० और आई० एस० एम० ने भारतीय बीमा कम्पनियों से कुल ४.६१ करोड़ रुपये के माल का बीमा सन् १९५४-५५ में कराया ।

भारतीय व विदेशी जहाजों से ले गये हुये माल का भ्रग भ्रलग व्योरा मौजूद नहीं है ।

Import of Horses

965. Shri Bibhuti Mishra : Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the number of horses imported from Australia in 1953 and 1954; and

(b) their value ?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari) : (a) and (b). A statement is attached. [See Appendix (IX annexure No. 60).]

Handloom Industry

966. Shri Ibrahim : Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state the number of workers employed in the Handloom Industry in India ?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari) : According to the Textile Enquiry Committee there are about 15.5 lakhs of active looms in the country barring Assam, Manipur and Tripura. A precise estimate of the number of workers will depend on the number of days each loom works and on the type of cloth woven. As these facts have not been established it is difficult to give any figure in respect of the number of workers employed.

Foreign Embassies

967. Shri Ibrahim : Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state :

(a) the number of foreign Embassies India the buildings of which are owned by the respective foreign countries ;

(b) the number of Embassies which have rented accommodation ; and

(c) the total monthly rent of the Government buildings leased to them ?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru) : (a) 12 diplomatic missions have either purchased or built their own buildings. Besides all other missions have acquired land in the Diplomatic Enclave and will be constructing their own buildings in the near future.

(b) 44, including those which have their own buildings.

(c) The amount of rent at present received by the Government of India from diplomatic missions in respect of Government owned buildings placed at their disposal is approximately Rs. 25,000 per mensem. This figure excludes the amount of rent for accommodation in Government owned hostels allotted to diplomatic missions on a temporary basis as the amount constantly varies.

Migration

968. Shri Ibrahim : Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state :

(a) the number of Muslims who migrated from India to East Pakistan during the last three years, yearwise ; and

(b) the number of non-Muslims who migrated to India from East Pakistan during the said period ?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru) : (a) The figures of Muslims who left India for East Pakistan on Pakistani Emergency Certificates, during the last three years beginning from the 15th October, 1952, the date on which the passport scheme of travel was introduced, to the end of July, 1955, are ;

(b) The figures of non-Muslims who have come over to India from East Pakistan, during the same period, on Migration Certificates issued by the Indian Deputy High Commissioner at Dacca, are :
