Capital Investment

64. { Shri Heda: . Shri P. Ramaswamy:

Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) the rate of capital investment in both the sectors during the last 3 years;
- (b) how this has been determined;
 - (c) the target in this regard?

The Minister of Finance (Shri C. D. Deshmukh.): (a) Estimates of capital formation in India for the years 1948-49 to 1953-54 have been worked out in a paper prepared by the Central Statistical Organisation. The paper is being placed on the Tabe of the House. [See Appendix I, annexure No. 43].

- (b) The method of estimation is explained in the paper.
- (c) No separate annual targets were worked out but the First Five Year Plan envisaged an average annual rate of investment of about 7 per cent of national income.
