

आकाशवाणी के दिल्ली केंद्र से हिन्दी की विभिन्न बोलियों में कितनी वार्ताएँ और लोक गीत प्रसारित किये गये ?

सूचना और प्रसारण मंत्री (डा० कसकर) : १९५४-५५ के वित्तीय वर्ष में अखिल भारतीय रेडियो के दिल्ली स्टेशन से हिन्दी की विभिन्न बोलियों में २११९ लोक गीत प्रसारित किये गये। साधारण कार्यक्रम में वार्ताएँ किसी बोली में प्रसारित नहीं की जातीं। किन्तु देहाती प्रोग्रामों के कुछ भागों से बोलियों का नियमित प्रयोग किया जाता है।

Government Publications

536. **Shri S. C. Samanta:** Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state the names of journals or publications which generally contain the maximum number of contributions from Government employees?

The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): Contributions from Government servants are ordinarily taken only in journals. Contributions by Government servants in the journals "Kuruksheera" and "Gram Sevak", which are mainly meant for departmental use by the Community Projects Administration, are not paid for and so too the contributions in the journal "Bhagirath" which is meant both for departmental use and general publicity. Of the other journals, the "March of India" which is essentially intended for foreign readers receives the largest number of paid contributions from Government servants, which, on an average, form one-third of the total number of contributions.

Industrial Development of Punjab

537. **Shri D. C. Sharma:** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the amount of financial aid asked for by the Government of Punjab for the industrial development of the State under the First Five Year Plan;

(b) the names of the industries which were helped and their locations; and

(c) the amount given by Government by way of grants and loans separately?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): (a) to (c). A statement is laid on the Table. [See Appendix V, annexure No. 37].

CLOTH EXPORT TO NEPAL

538. **Shri Bibhuti Mishra:** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government propose to remove all restrictions on the export of cloth from India to Nepal; and

(b) if so, whether any instructions have been issued to the Uttar Pradesh Government to abolish the licensing system?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): (a) There are no restrictions on the export of cloth from India to Nepal.

(b) Presumably, the Honourable Member is referring to the licensing system of cloth and yarn for the local dealers introduced by the U. P. Government. If so, it is understood that that Government have decided to continue the licensing system for a further period of one year with effect from the 1st October, 1955.

Tea Industry

539. **Shri D. C. Sharma:** Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state the amount of foreign capital invested in the Tea Industry in India (State-wise) during the last 5 years?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): According to information available, the total foreign investments in the tea industry amounted to Rs. 50.31 crores at the end of June 1948 and Rs. 70.83 crores at the end of December 1953. Figures yearwise or State-wise are not available.

(a) the number of Indian newsreels sent abroad for exhibition during 1955-56 so far; and

(b) the total amount realised from these newsreels?
