Atomic Energy Co-operation Agreement

Shri Shree Narayan Das: Shri M. L. Dwivedi: Shri M. L. Agrawal:

Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state whether negotiations are in progress for concluding an Atomic Energy Co-operation Agreement with the U.S.A.?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): No such negotiations are at present in progress, but there have been discussions between the U.S.A. and India regarding mutual assistance in the field of atomic energy.

Elephant Hunt Scheme in N.E.F.A.

688. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state how many elephants have been captured by the N.E.F.A. Administration under the Elephant Hunt Scheme so far?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): Altogether 221 elephants have been captured so far. The elephant hunting operation is generally carried out by Mahaldars who sell the captured elephants to the public. Sealed tenders are invited and the Mahaldars pay royalty to Government at fixed rates.

Migration from East Pakistan

Shri D. C. Sharma: Shri K. P. Sinha: Shri Bibhuti Mishra: Sardar Iqbal Singh:

Will the Minister of Rehabilitation bepleased to state:

- (a) whether there was recently a meeting between him and the Union Minister of Law and Minority Affairs to discuss the steps to be taken to stem the increased tempo of migration from East Pakistan to West Bengal and other States of India;
- (b) if so, what were the decisions arrived at; and
- (c) whether these dicisions have be communicated to the Pakistan Gover.a-ment?

The Deputy Minister of Rehabilitation (Shri J. K. Bhonsle): (a) Yes.

- (c) The matter has been taken up with the Pakistan Government.
