61. **Shri D. C. Sharma** : Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state the amount spent on the maintenance of the Humayun's Tomb during the three years ending 1954?

**The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. Das)** : Rs. 1,27,829 during 1952-1955.

#### Preventive Detention

62. **Shri D. C. Sharma** : Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to lay a statement on the Table of the House showing the total number of persons State-wise detained at present under the Preventive Detention Act?

**The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Datar)** : A statement showing the number of persons in detention on the 30th September, 1955, is laid on the Table of the House. [See Appendix I, Annexure No. 34].

#### Kidnapped Children

63. **Shri B. D. Shastri** : Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the number of children who were kidnapped in Delhi in the year 1955 upto 1 October;

(b) the number of girls among them;

(c) the number of children recovered so far ;

(d) how does these figures compare with the figures of the corresponding period for the year 1954; and

(e) what steps Government have taken to check kidnapping?

**The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Datar)** : (a) to (e), the information asked for is being collected from the Delhi State Government and will be laid on the Table of the House as soon as it is received.

#### Scheduled Castes in Service

64. **Shri I. Eacharan** : Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state the number of persons belonging to Scheduled Castes who were appointed as Assistants, Assistant Superintendents, Superintendents, Class II, and Class I Officers during the period from October, 1954 to September, 1955 in the Central Secretariat and the Attached and Subordinate Offices?

**The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Datar)** : A statement is laid on the Table of the Lok Sabha. [See Appendix I, Annexure No. 35].

#### Civil Suits by Government Servants

65. **Shri Ibrahim** : Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of civil suits by Central Government servants filed in respect of their emoluments or dismissal or discharge against the State during 1954-1955, (State-wise) ; and

(b) the total number of suits referred to in part (a) above decreed by the first court in favour of Plaintiffs during 1954-1955 (State-wise) ?

**The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Datar)** : (a) and (b). The information is not readily available and its collection would involve an undue amount of time and labour.

#### Banks in Punjab

66. **Shri D. C. Sharma** : Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the Banks, with headquarters in Punjab, which have failed since the 15th of August, 1947;

(b) the amount of deposits in each Bank; and

(c) the total amount paid so far to the depositors?
