INDO-PAKISTAN TALKS

Shri Kamath :

Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

(a) whether a Conference was held at Dacca on the 5th and 6th May, 1956 between the representatives of the Government of India and the representatives of the Pakistan Government to discuss the problems of exodus from East Bengal; and

(b) if so, the results achieved?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) Yes.

(b) It is too early to mention any tangible results. A copy of the Joint Communiqué issued at the conclusion of the Conference will be placed on the Table of the House on receipt.

EDUCATION IN N.E.F.A.

1936. **Shri Rishang Keishang**: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

(a) the number of tribal boys and girls from North East Frontier Agency trained in the Basic Training School at Margherita, so far;

(b) the amount of stipends awarded to the trainees; and

(c) how and where the successful trainees are given employment?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) to (c). 27 tribal boys and one girl from North East Frontier Agency are being trained in the basic system of education and 16 boys and 2 girls are being trained in Hindi at the Basic Education Training Institute at Margherita. Each trainee is being given a stipend of Rs. 50 per month. The trainees have not yet completed their training, and it is intended to employ them in their own areas, as far as possible, after they have completed their training.
