(c) what is the estimated increase in requirements of the same during the Second Plan; (d) how much of the same has been sanctioned for provision in the Second Plan; and

(e) the number of locomotives allotted for Assam section in the years 1955 to 1960 and what number will be condemned?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) to (e). A statement is placed on the Table of the Lok Sabha. [See Appendix XII, annexure No. 46]

#### **ROLLING STOCK**

1939. Chaudhuri Muhammed Shaffee: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) the total amount paid so far for rolling stocks imported by Government from the 1st January, 1955 to the 31st March, 1956;

(b) the total amount yet to be paid; and

(c) the quantity of rolling stocks exported by Government during the same period and the value thereof?

**The Deputy Minister of Railways** and **Transport (Shri Alagesan):** (a) Rs. 19.4 crores\*

(b) Rs. 4.6 crores\*

(c) Export—Nil. However 28 unfurnished coach body shells and 22 Belgian underframes were supplied to North Western Railway Pakistan in June, '55 against their share out of prepartition order at an estimated cost of Rs. 22 lakhs.

#### **RAILWAY EMPLOYEES**

1940. Shri P. L. Barupal: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that at the time of regrouping of railways in 1952, the Adjudicator's Award had not been implemented in ex-Bikaner Division but it was implemented on Delhi-Fazilka-Rewari Section;

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(b) whether it resulted in incorrect estimates of various railway employees in these two sections particularly in transportation and commercial categories;

(c) whether even at present Delhi-Fazilka-Rewari Section is considered a bigger unit than *ex*-Bikaner Division for purposes of preparation of seniority resulting in supersession of staff of *ex*-Bikaner State Railway; and

(d) if so, the action taken to redress their grievances?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) There was no Bikaner Division before regrouping on 14-4-1952. The Adjudicator's Award was not implemented on the *ex*-Bikaner State Railway.

(b) No Sir, the need for estimates did not arise.

(c) The combined seniority of staff of the Fazilka-Rewari Section of the ex-B.B. & C.I. Railway and the ex-Bikaner State Railway has been based on certain approved principles.

(d) No action is necessary.

### **RAILWAY CONTRACTS**

1941. Shri N. Rachiah: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a heavy loss was caused due to the way of giving contracts for collection of jelly for the use of Railway at Tyakal Station near Malur Kolar District Southern Railway during 1950-51;

(b) if so, whether any enquiry has been held so far;

(c) the officers responsible for this heavy loss;

(d) the extent of loss and whether it has been recovered;

(e) how did this occur; and

(f) the action taken by Government?

The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) to (c). No; there was no loss. A representation had been received on behalf of one of the contractors alleging irregularities and fraud in the award of contracts but full investigations established that there was nothing *mala fide* in placing the contracts, nor was there any loss to the Government. As such the question of holding any of the officers responsible did not arise.

(d) to (f). Do not arise.
