examination of these applications, this aspect viz., proper use of funds and rates of expenditure is also watched by the Reserve Bank.

Written Answers

The Reserve Bank also undertakes a voluntary inspection of the State and Central Banks particularly those which avail themselves of concessional finance to ensure that there is no misuse of the funds.

(b) Co-operative institutions under the Statutory control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies of the respective States and are governed by the Co-operative Societies Act and the Rules framed thereunder. Restrictions regarding the maximum rate of dividend are generally laid down in the Act and Rules of each State. Similarly control over expenditure is exercised generally through the Rules, Departmental instructions and periodical audit of accounts by of the Co-operative the Officials Department.
