the platform at the station at an estimated cost of Rs. 48,000/- is sanctioned and the work is in progress. There is already a waiting hall here.

The provision of foot over-bridge is not a necessity due to the very few number of trains in the section.

It may be mentioned here that very recently the following works also have been carried out at the station:—

- (i) Vegetarian Refreshment Room;
- (ii) Shelter for drinking water;
- (iii) Sanitary fittings and flushing system in the bath room of upper class waiting room;
- (iv) One four-seated flushing urinal near III class waiting hall; and
  - (v) Bathing facilities.
