Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) to what extent the poor people will get relief by the exemption of excise duty on *dhoties* and *sarees* of coarse varieties in view of their production in negligible quantity; and
- (b) the supply with reference to the production figures of different varieties of cloth for the months of November and December, 1955?

The Minister of Revenue and Defence Expenditure (Shri A. C. Guha):
(a) The Honourable Member is presumably referring to the exclusion of coarse dhoties and saris from the recent increase of six pies per square yard in the exicse duty on Cotton Fabrics. The relief to the consumer by this exclusion is estimated at Rs. 5 lakhs for the current financial year.
