1154. Sardar Iqbal Singh : Sardar Akarpuri :

Will the Minister of Planning be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of loans and grants for the local development works sanctioned and drawn by the States of Punjab and Pepsu in 1953-54, 1954-55 and 1955-56 so far;
- (b) the details of the local works completed in these States during 1953-54, 1954-55, and 1955-56 so far;
- (c) whether any direct aid was given by the Centre for any local work done or proposed to be done by any private agency in these States; and
 - (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) whether it is a fact that the amount of grant or aid given by the Central Government to the Government of Hyderbad State for village and small scale Industries was not utilised in full by the State Government during 1954-55 and 1955-56; and
- (b) if so, whether the State Government has been asked to state the circumstances in which the amount could not be utilised?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry and Iron and Steel (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The slow progress in the utilisation of funds sanctioned to the State Government has been brought to the notice of the State Government and the tSate Government have been requested to expedite the implementation of the schemes.
