# KHWANG-MORASS LINE TO DIBRUGARH

2324. Shri K. P. Tripathi : Will the Minister of **Railways** be pleased to state whether there is a proposal to extend the Khwang-Morass line to Dibrugarh?

#### RIVER CONSERVANCY

(1) Dredging of Key shoals and approaches to important river ghats on the Brahmaputra.

(2) Snag-clearing on the Brahmaputra.

(3) Installation of automatic beacons for Night navigation on the Brahmaputra.

(c) No. The schemes mentioned above have been included in the Second Five Year Plan of the Ganga Brahmaputra Water Transport Board, which functions with financial assistance from the Central and State Governments. PETROLEUM TRANSPORT
