The Punjab and the Pepsu Fisheries Development Schemes included in the Second Five Year Plan amount to Rs. 5.00 lakhs and Rs. 6.00 lakhs, respectively. These figures include Rs. 4 lakhs for Punjab and Rs. 3 lakhs for Pepsu, as Central assistance under Grow More Food Schemes. These figures are, however, provisional.
