The Deputy Minister of Health (Shrimati Chandrasekhar): (a) The activities of the Rajkumari Sports Coaching Scheme are to supplement the coaching programmes of the National Sports Organisations, to establish coaching schools all over the country for youth and to impart specialised coaching in Athletics and the following sports:—

(i) Foot Ball.

(iii) Cricket.
