Shencottah Taluk in Travancore-Cochin State to enable to division of the same between that State and the State of Madras?

The Minister in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar): Yes. The Government of Travancore-Cochin has undertaken, with the concurrence of the Government of India, a survey of the area in question, with a view to fixing the boundary between the prospective States of Kerla and Madras.

## CITIZENSHIP ACT
