has been collected regarding the Korea Coalfield, the opening up of an open cast mine and one underground mine in this area has been sanctioned, and orders for various essential items of machinery required have been placed by the D.G., S.D. Steps have also been taken to open training centres for the training of the technical staff required it connection with the development plans. Drilling has also been started in Karunpura and will be taken up shortly in Kathars and Jhilimlli-Bisrsmpur areas and working plans for these areas will be drawn up after intensive prospecting has been completed, The transport requirements have also been assessed and communicated to the Ministry of Railways.

### Border Incident

540. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of border incidents which have occurred during the period from the 1st of May, 1936 to the end of July, 1956 on the Indo-Pakisten borders of East Pakistan; and
- (b) the extent of loss of life and property on the Indian side?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Finance (Shri Jawaharlai Nehru): (a) 34 incidents were reported during the period from the 1st May to the 15th July, 1956. Information in respect of the second fortnight of July is still awaited from the State Governments concerned.

(b) One Indian national was killed and another kidnapped. Properties worth Rs. 5,500 and 104 head of cattle were lost.
