The itinerary of visiting cultural trouges is determined on the basis of availability of particular type and size of stage and lighting arrangements; air transportation facilities for carrying heavy equipment of the troupes which visit India for short durations; appropriate hotel and food arrangements in the city of visit and availability of suitable organisation to present the shows
