Resignation of Babubhai Patel Ministry of Gujarat

1871, SHRI MAGANBHAI BAROT: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Shri Babhubhai Patel, Ex-Chief Minister, Gujarat had himself declared, immediately after results of Lok Sabha Poll, that he intends to tender the resignation of his Government in view of the poll outcome being against his party; and
- (b) is it true that the State Government had earlier agreed to hold Assembly elections along with Lok Sabha poll, but subsequently changed stand from time to time?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFAIRS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b) According to the facts furnished by the State Government, they have no information regarding part (a) of the question. As regards part (b), their reply is in the negative. It has also been confirmed by the Election Commission of India that they did not receive any formal communication from the State Government regarding holding of Assembly General Elections with the Lok Sabha General Elections, 1980. It has been added that the then Chief Minister of Gujarat had a discussion with the Chief Election commisioner in the matter when the latter was at Ahmedabad in September, 1979. However, the matter was not pursued by the State Government.
