THE MINISTER OF INFORMA-TION AND BROADCASTING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) in connection with the Lok Sabha Elections, 1980, all the recognised national parties were allowed two broadcasts each on the national hook-up Delhi, each State/Union Territory which went to the poll allowed two broadcasts to each of the national parties as also the recognised State parties in the respective States. These broadcasts were from all other stations except commercial centres, in the concerned States.
