Memorandum against General Manager of Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited. Talcher Division

A copy of an unsigned printed letter addressed to the Prime Minister purporting to be from "officers and workers of the Talcher Division" and containing allegations of wastage of public funds and harassment and victimisation of employees General Manager of Talcher Division of Fertilizer Corporation of India was received in the Ministry in July, 1980. The allegations are being looked into.

L.P. Gas Connections Applications in Mangalore

7700. SHRI JANARDHANA POOJARY: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

- (a) what is the number of applications pending for the issue of gas connections in Mangalore; and
- (b) how many connections were given there during this year?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) The number of applications pending for the issue of gas connections in Mangalore with Indian Oil Corporation and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation are about 3 700.

(b) During current year in April and May 1980. Indian Oil Corporation had sanctioned 45 new connections. Termination vouchers during these two menths totalled to 53. No New gas-connections have been released by Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. during the current year.

Sanctioning the Energy Projects Received from Government of Maharashtra

7701. SHRI BALASAHEB VIKHE PATIL: Will the Minister of ENERGY AND COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government has fixed any time limit for sanctioning the energy projects received from the State Governments and also for speedy implementation thereof with a view to check inflation and to become self-reliant in the interest of national economy;
- (b) if not, the reasons for not fixing such time limit; and
- (c) what projects have been received from the Government of Maharashtra separately each year during 1978, 1979 and 1980 (upto 30-6-1980) and which of those are pending with

the Central Government and how much more time will the Central Government take to sanction them?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN); (a) & (b). No time limit has been fixed for sanctioning of the power generation projects submitted by State Governments to the Central authorities and for the implementation of such projects. Each project has to pass through the various stages of techno-economic appraisal before it is accorded techno-economic clearance by the Central Electricity Authority and recommended Planning Commission for their investment decision and approval. The time taken in the examination of a project and establishment of its techno-economic viability depends, inter-alia, upon the adequacy of technical details furnished in the project report, the extent of site investigations and studies involved the inter-State aspects to be resolved and the availability of coal/ gas and its transportation. Minister of Energy has, however, desired that

the processes of techno-economic appraisal should be accelerated and States informed of further information required or modifications necessary within two to three months. After the techno-economic clearance, investment decision and final approval of the project, all efforts are made to monitor the execution of projects and their commissioning within the targeted dates, but sometimes slippages become unavoidable due to various reasons. Adequacy of existing construction agencies methods and techniques. supply of equipment and procedures for purchase of equipment, etc., are reviewed from time to time to ensure speedy construction of projects.

(c) The project reports for thermal power generation projects received from the Government of Maharashtra/Maharashtra State Electricity Board during the years 1978, 1979 and 1980 (upto 30-6-1980) and their present status are shown in the Statement attached. No hydro-electric power generation project was submitted to the Central Electricity Authority during these three years.
