Import of Crude Oil

7739. SHRI RAMJIBHAI MAVANI: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

(a) how many countries agreed to supply crude oil and other petroleum products to India during 1978, 1979 and 1980 and the details thereof;

(b) how much has been received during three years;

(c) what further steps are being taken to import large quantity of crude as well as for increasing production; and

(d) the encouragement and incentive to be offered in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF FETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA FATIL): (a) During 1978 India had imported crude oil from five countries and for the year 1979 India imported crude oil from Eight countries. For the year 1980 (upto June 1980) contracts have been concluded with six countries for supply of crude oil. The details of the countries from which $crud_e$ oil has been received are as under:

(c) The Government intends to meet the import requirements of crude in the future also by supplies from our traditional sources a_s also from new potential sources that are being explored at present. Attempts are also being made to intensify our exploration activities and plans are being made for the exploitation of our established reserves with a view to increase the indigenous production of crude oil.

(d) Crude Oil contracts are generally concluded with Government owned companies of the Oil Producing and Exporting Countries. Imports of Petroleum Products are also effected either by negotiating with government owned companies of Oil Producing and Exporting Countries or by floating tenders. In view of this need for offering any special incentive in the matter does not arise.

Oil Exploration in Gujarat

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7740. SHRI MOHAN LAL PATEL: Wil the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that there are more possibilities of oil exploration in some parts of Gujarat;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by Government for its exploration;

(c) how many surveys have been conducted and reports presented of such oil exploration during the last three years and during 1st February to 15th July, 1980 and surveys which are likely to be conducted during 1980, 1981 and 1982; and

(d) the results and outcome of the said surveys and how and when it will come into effect?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) Yes Sir

(b) There are more possibilities of oil exploration in the Cambay Basin and the Shoal area of the Gulf of Cambay. ONGC propose to detect and explore stratigraphic and subtle traps by using more sophisticated techniques.

(c) A total of 18 party years of seismic work has been carried out in Gujarat during the last 3 years, viz., 1977-78, 1979-80, and 41 reports 1978-79 and submitted. During the period 1st February, 1980 to 15th July, 1980, 6 seismic parties operated in Gujarat, and submitted 4 reports. Over the next 3 years viz., 1980-81, 1981-82 and 1982-83, 27 party years of seismic surveys is proposed to be carried out. In addition, it is also proposed to carry out shallow marine seismic surveys in some areas

(d) the data collected in 1979-80 is under processing. The results of surveys made earlier are being continuously made use of in the exploration programme. It is a continuing process-
