## Theft of store in Delhi Telephone District

4001. SHRI CHANDRABHAN ATHARE PATIL: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether stores worth several lakhs of Rupees were stolen sometime back in Delhi Telephones District:
- (b) if so, the approximate value of these stores, the modus operandi of the theit; the efforts made to recover them and fix responsibility for the loss to the Exchequer;
- (c) whether some officers involved were suspended and if so, the total amount of suspension allowance and other allowances paid to them till 1-7-1980; and
- (d) the measures taken to prevent such losses in future?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI KARTIK ORAON): (a) and (b). Yes Sir. The Central Bureau of Investigation investigated a case of loss of Stores worth Rs. 5.5 lakhs in 1974. The stores were taken out of the Central Stores Depot, Delhi by producing fake requisitions by certain officers. On the basis of the C.B.I. the advice of the report and on Central Vigilance Commission, sanction for proseaution have been issued against the officers/officials concerned. The result of the prosecution case is awaited.

- (c) Yes Sir. The total amount of subsistance and other allowances paid to them was Rs. 2,24,583/- upto 1-7-1980.
- (d) Preventive vigilance measures have been taken including the setting up of Vigilance Flying Squads in Delhi Telephones District.
