- (iv) Decanalisation of rubber imports.
- (v) Subsidising rubber imports from rubber cess collection.
- (vi) To give fair representation to rubber consuming industry on the Rubber Board.

The points raised are already receiving attention of Government.

Construction of Type II Quarters, for the Employees of Kiriburu Iron ore Mines

608. SHRI HARIHAR SOREN: Will the Miniser of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that funds have been sanctioned for the construction of 200 type II Quarters for the employees of the Kiriburu Iron Ore Mines out of the Iron Ore Mines Cess fund subsidy;

Out of the subsidy offered, Rs. 1,07,000 has so far been received by the Bokaro management which is still examining financing as well as the mode of construction for the housing scheme in its totality.
