(c) and (d) Following the increase in prices of steel effected from the 9th February, 1981, Government have decided that eligible export contracts for engineering goods subsisting as on the 8th February, 1981 will be afforded price protection in respect of steel and pig iron, with reference to the price increase effected on the 9th February, 1981. Further, in respect of exports of engineering goods effected in implementation of other export contracts, it has been decided that international prices will be charged for steel. The total amount to be reimbursed under these schemes will depend upon the quantity of the steel to be released for the export contracts covered by the decisions mentioned above
